When is testing available?

COVID-19 Testing is available Monday-Friday 8:30 AM-4:30 PM and is by Appointment Only.

Saturday test times vary and are by Appointment Only.

When is the SWDH COVID-19 Testing Phone Line open?

The SWDH COVID-19 Testing phone number line is open Monday-Friday 7:30 AM-7:30 PM (MST).

Saturday and Sunday COVID-19 Testing phone line can be reached over the weekend.

Who is Southwest District Health testing for COVID-19?

SWDH is testing symptomatic:

- District 3 residents or employees
- First Responders
- Educational teacher/staff/students
- Medical personnel
- Vulnerable populations

I am in one of the groups listed above, but what does symptomatic mean?

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear **2-14 days after exposure to the virus.** People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

- Headache
 New loss of
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose

Fatigue Muscle or body aches

- Nausea or vomitingDiarrhea
- Diarrh
