What is defining success for this program- ensure it is rural focused data- what services are provided, accessibility, what is the presenting issue and is it resolved at the end of services, what other community resources were they referred to and how many followed through and were they satisfied with those services. Utilization of a future or hope index or a grit index- Was the experience meaningful to the youth, what is their understanding of why they are receiving services, or how was their experience with receiving services, what disparities is the system set up to address. A workgroup will be established to further this discussion and make suggestions on measures of success for YouthROC program.</i></p>	Savannah S
