			Overall census has gone down mainly due to a decrease of repeat visitors (they are	
			doing well or engaging in other diversion services). The number of first-time visitors	
			are increasing.	
			Gender breakdown with census is as expected, however, agency referrals are	
			increasing. Additionally, January services were almost all mental health only, with	
			only one substance use only and 13 dual services.	

			Diversions in January include mostly hospital and 911/LE diversions, with some diversions from drug/alcohol use and harm to self or others. Abigail announced her transition from R3 centers to R4 centers, due to the departure of R4's program manager. A new program manager has been identified. Abigail will onboard and provide support throughout this transition.
