There was a broken link that has been fixed, and this may address the difference.</li> <li>• Funding/Budget Updates – budget for next FY is done and we should be whole and able to cover through the end of FY26. Did submit Title 2 Funding Application through IDJC for an additional case manager for NFJC. Assessment centers gained an audience with the Millennium Fund Committee and our requests (1 emergency application and 1 FY26 application totaling about \$3M) with assessment centers included were approved. Savannah is still reviewing JFAC sessions and will be following up. We should be very hopeful that we’ve been given consideration.</li> <li>• CAP60 Update – Have bumped go live into March. The Clarvida team is having a successful transition. We really appreciate all your support. Reminder that the new location is 308 E. Hawaii Ave. in Nampa. The ages served are now 5 to 17 years old. The center capacity is higher at 9 versus the 6 we had at the temporary center. Any old print materials should be recycled and please reach out to Cas for new materials with the up-to-date location address. At the open house there was an opportunity to see the successes. Reviewed the successes as presented at the open house.</li> <li>• Funding/Budget Updates –Cas’ supervisor, Michelle is working with Magellan to get a signed contract, there does seem to be some movement. No news yet about when billings will start. We started pursuing the contract on July 2, 2024.</li> <li>• Monthly update from Clarvida – this is Abigail’s last time presenting Drew will be the new program manager. Shared some numbers. The center is starting to see an uptick. As this continues, we will be looking into where the uptick is coming from. Caldwell High School recently included the youth support center in their “cause week.” Shared client demographics. The new facility is wonderful, and we also have a new program manager and a new age range to celebrate. All good things. Comment was made that sometimes in the cases of youth we can do more in the civil system than the criminal system. We did see a 9-year-old last week.
