This is a good visual overview of who is using YouthROC, how serving the youth is going and shares a couple experiences. Referral numbers are low ever since the parental consent law. ○ Question – Jeannie asked how we think the new law is lowering referrals. Savannah shared that there’s a lot of hesitation, notably in schools if they don’t have consent from the parent(s). They are giving information out for self-referral instead of performing direct referrals. ○ Jeannie talked about how many case managers there are currently and the question of how to keep moving forward with what staffing we have. Some of the case managers have expressed feeling overloaded. Savannah is evaluating. ○ Request - Drew asked if Savannah could provide Youth Crisis Center with an update and refresher.
